Q

What is Hearts in Harmony?

A

Hearts in Harmony is a collaborative arts event bringing together students from Lillian Osborne catchment schools to celebrate love, friendship, community, and the arts through music, dance, and visual art.

Q

When and where is the event?

A

- Date: Sunday, February 15
- Location: Maclab Theatre South located in Lillian Osborne High School 2019 Leger Rd

Q

What is the schedule for the day?

A

- 11:30 pm - Student arrival
- 12:00-1:30 pm - Dress rehearsal
- 2:00-3:00 pm - Performance

Q

What is the theme of the show?

A

Hearts in Harmony celebrates love, friendship, family, community, and connection through the arts. The focus is on collaboration, inclusivity, and bringing students together in a joyful, shared experience.

Q

What is the group finale?

A

All participating students will gather on stage at the end of the show to perform a simple, feel-good finale song with Ariana Whitlow. Schools will be asked to do light rehearsal only, once the song is selected.

Q

Do students need special costumes?

A

No. Staff are welcome to choose what their group wears. This can be: "Sunday best", A specific colour theme, or something simple. Students will be provided with a free Hearts in Harmony t-shirt to wear during the finale.

Q

Is there a cost for the student?

A

- No cost for participating students
- Students receive a free Hearts in Harmony t-shirt
- Guest tickets will be \$10 (ticketing details shared in January)

Q

What is the time commitment for staff?

A

Participation is designed to be flexible and respectful of staff time. Only one combined rehearsal on the day of the event is required. SEATS will manage staging, transitions, and technical support.

Q

Do teachers need to attend the event?

A

Yes, at least one staff supervisor is required for performing groups on the day of the event. If a school is participating only through visual art, staff attendance at the event is not required.

Q

How can families watch the performance?

A

Families can purchase tickets from an online website for \$10 each. More information on ticket sales will be shared shortly.

Q

How long should each group's performance be?

A

There is no minimum length for each performance, however the maximum should be approximately 3-4 minutes. This helps ensure the full program stays within the one-hour performance window.

Q

Will students be photographed or recorded?

A

Yes. We hope to have the show captured with both video and photographs. A SEATS Ambassador may also take photographs for promotional use on the SEATS website and social media.

Q

What accessibility supports are available at the theatre?

A

Maclab Theatre South is an accessible venue, including: accessible seating options, wheelchair access, and accessible washrooms.
